Re: ESTABLISHMENT OF THE NATIONAL CONSULTATIVE FORUM TASKFORCE

The Prime Minister of the Federal Republic of Somalia

Having Seen: Articles 99 & 100 of the Provisional Constitution of the Federal Republic of Somalia

Having Seen: The Action Plan and Guiding Principles on the Electoral Process for 2016, which were endorsed by the High-Level Partnership Forum held in Mogadishu on 29-30 July 2015.

Having Held: Comprehensive consultations with other Federal Government Institutions, Federal Member States/Administrations, civil society and other stakeholders for inclusivity, transparency, and unity on vision 2016 plans.

Having Considered: The recent National Leadership Forum (NLF) held in Mogadishu, Somalia on September 21-23rd, 2015 that called for the establishment of a Task Force to support the National Consultative Forum (NCF) by advising on and ensuring implementation of the consultative process.

PROMULGATES:

Article 1

Membership of the Taskforce

The Taskforce will consist of five (5) Federal Ministers; Interior and Federal Affairs, Women and Human Rights, Justice, Constitutional Affairs, and Information, and; a Minister representing each of the Regional States/Administration, and; a representative from each of the Offices of the Prime Minister, the Speaker, and the President.

Article 2

Roles of the Taskforce

1. Recommends for approval to the NCF a facilitation guide & organizes series of structured consultations set out in the Action Plan.
2. Facilitates effective political coordination and communication among the National Consultative Forum members
3. Mobilizes resources to implement the Action Plan
4. Engages in direct consultation with stakeholders in each of the regions to enhance the outreach and legitimacy of the National Consultative Forum

Article 3

Execution of this appointment

This appointment will go into effect upon the signature of the Prime Minister of the Federal Republic of Somalia and a list with the individual representatives names will be attached for publications.
